

Important information on COVID Vaccinations in Bromley

Over 80% of eligible Bromley residents have now been vaccinated. Our thanks to everyone who has taken the time to ensure they get their vaccination, and to our amazing staff and volunteers.

Getting your first vaccine

If you are over 50, a carer or clinically vulnerable and not yet had your vaccine, please book as soon as you can. As well as the Bromley Civic Centre, there are appointments available at Bromley GP vaccination sites. Please contact your local vaccination site to book.

What do to if you are due for your second dose

The nationally agreed gap between the first and second dose of the vaccine for COVID-19 is between 11 to 12 weeks.

Everyone who has had their first vaccine has a second vaccine reserved for them. Your second dose will be the same vaccine as your first one.

Appointments for second dose vaccines are being offered to everyone who is due to have one. Please wait to be contacted with your appointment. You will usually get your second dose at the same place as where you had your first appointment.

If your first vaccine was at Community House, this has now closed and two new sites have been opened. You will be contacted to book your appointment and advised where to go for your second dose. Please see the table opposite to find your GP practice and your corresponding local vaccination service.

If you had your first vaccine at one of our clinical satellite clinics, such as Al-Emaan Mosque, Anerley Town Hall or a GP practice, you will be contacted by 11 weeks to advise where you will have your second dose.

If it is 11 weeks since your first dose but you have not yet been contacted to book your second appointment, please call the appropriate vaccination site. Details are opposite:

Q I had a text inviting me for the vaccine. Is it genuine?

A NHS services are using text messages as one of the ways to invite people in for their vaccine. A genuine message will never ask for your bank details or request a payment. It may ask you to confirm your date of birth to make sure the message has reached the intended person. If you receive a text message which looks suspicious, you can forward this free of charge to the 7726 SMS reporting service.
